- **A licensing agreement with First DataBank** to give EDIMS' hospital clients medication reconciliation from triage through disposition.

This designation will enable EDIMS customers to meet the Stage 1 meaningful use measures required to qualify eligible providers and hospitals for funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). EDIMS 2.6 certification number is CC-1112-430980-1.
